Friday, September 1, is the first day for <u>freshmen only</u> and their parents. The first full day for <u>all students</u> is Tuesday, September 5.

<u>Chromebook Distribution</u>: The School District of the Menomonie Area will be providing Chromebook computers for all high school students to be used at school and home during the 2017-2018 school year as part of a 1:1 computer program called the 1:1 M-Powered Learning Initiative. New Chromebook computers will be distributed to students for use at home and at school on **Thursday, August 17, for 11th and 12th graders** and **Monday, August 21, for 9th and 10th graders**. On Orientation Day plan to spend at least two hours meeting your teachers, guidance counselor, principal, and assistant principal. Visit classrooms, gather school information, practice your locker combination, complete necessary forms, and pay fees. Visit the health room to update immunization and health records. Students new to MMS or 6th grade students who missed orientation in August may attend a mini session offered at 10:00 a.m. or 4:00 p.m. on September 1 in our LMC.

September 1 is also Picture Day! Student pictures will be taken by *Lifetouch* staff in the pod areas. Wear your best smile and favorite school clothes! Retakes will be scheduled in October.

All Menomonie area elementary students are required to attend Orientation Day. A parent/guardian or other responsible adult must accompany the student. In order to better accommodate all families, we encourage you to attend at the times specified in a welcome letter you will receive from your school. If the time scheduled is inconvenient, you may come at another time. If you haven't received your welcome letter by Wednesday, August 23, please call your school's office.

Things to Do on Orientation Day

- Visit the cafeteria and meet the Food Service team as available.
- Meet your school's PTO/PTC officers as available.
- Verify address and busing information; share special info or concerns with office staff regarding your child(ren), especially medical needs. Picture Day information is available at each site. Elementary schools are similar in instructional time, but start and end times vary due to busing.
