WEAPONS ON SCHOOL PREMISES

Use or possession of a weapon (except where permitted by law and/or written board agreement or exception) and threats involving such items by any individual shall be prohibited at school, on school grounds or at school-sponsored activities. For purposes of this policy, "weapons" means explosives, incendiary agents, firearms, ammunition, martial arts equipment or other weapons of any type. Depending upon the circumstances, a knife or a look-alike weapon may be treated as a weapon.

District students who violate this policy shall be referred to local law enforcement officials or the juvenile delinquency system and may be subject to school discipline, including expulsion from school in accordance with the law.

District employees who violate this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the current employee handbook and board policy and shall be reported to local law enforcement officials.

Any other individual who violates this policy shall be reported to local law enforcement officials.
